CITY COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES

Mayor Scott Fitzgerald called the meeting to order. Councilmen present were David Bergart, Brent Douglass and Grant Thompson.

Motion was made and seconded to approve the amended March 10th meeting minutes. The ayes were unanimous.

County Commissioner- Bob Benedict

Teton County Commissioner Bob Benedict asked the Council for support with a two year, one million dollar per year levy for the Road & Bridge Department in the County. Mr. Benedict explained the current road conditions in the county to the Council. Commissioner Benedict explained that 10% of all funds generated in the County will return back to the city's road fund to be used according to the city's discretion. Council gave support with getting the information out for the citizens to understand the need.

Transportation Plan- Fire District Concerns

Teton County Fire Marshall Bret Campbell, Fire Chief Mike Hoyle, and Robert Dalton (Fire Board Commissioner, addressed the Council with a concern the Fire District has with the transportation plan. The nearly completed plan requires only 20 feet for city streets, which meets the International Fire Code. The Fire District has a resolution requiring 24 feet road width for fire equipment to maneuver safely and still allow traffic to be able to pass through during an emergency. The Fire District will set up a work meeting with the Council to address the concern.

Sign Ordinance- Continuation of Public Hearing

The discussion was continued from the previous Council meeting on the proposed sign ordinance. Planning and Zoning Administrator Cari Golden went through the changes made from the previous meeting with the Council. After some discussion and some clarification given, it was agreed upon to continue the discussion till the next meeting.

A motion was made and seconded to continue the discussion until the next meeting. Motion passed unanimously.

Sewer Discussion

City Engineer Rob Heuseveldt addressed the Council with an analysis regarding the different alternatives for wastewater treatment. Council discussed all the option including staying with Driggs and becoming a partner in their plant.

Council would like to meet with the City of Driggs to work out the details of the contract.

CIP- RFP Discussion

City Planner Bill Knight informed the Council of three proposals that were received for the Capital Improvements Plan Proposal (CIP). The Council discussed each proposal.

A motion was made and seconded to employ TischlerBise for the services of the CIP at a cost of \$57,480.00. The ayes were unanimous.

Park and Rec Committee- Update

Mrs. Golden updated the Council about the stakeholders clean up day in the park on May 22nd. Mrs. Golden will be getting a list of items that need done from Public Works Department to present to the committee.

Maintenance

Public Works Director Scott Golden asked to postpone the back flow video for a future meeting. Council agreed.

Administrative

Mr. Sherman presented an update of the Yellowstone Grand Teton Loop Road. Mr. Sherman, Councilman Ziem and Dahvi Wilson representing Envision Victor attended the meeting. Councilman Ziem previously volunteered to serve on the board.

Bills

A motion was made and seconded to pay the bills. The ayes were unanimous. Meeting was adjourned.
