FLAP Grant. Rob Heuseveldt made staff comment pertaining to the amendment to the Federal Lands Access program (FLAP) Grant Agreement for the Teton Centennial Pathway along with a supplementary FLAP grant application for improved access to the pathway, the revised cost estimates, and applying for a second FLAP grant for the under-grade tunnel crossing. Further deliberation was made in regards to the updated changes, the possibility of more cost adjustments and the pathway connectivity to Victor.
