Victor City Council met in regular session in the Council Chambers in City Hall at 32 Elm Street at 7:00 P.M. Upon roll call the following were found to be present:

Teton Valley Youth Alliance Council Presentation. Jill Naylor Yarger made public comment regarding ways that we can help youth connect with the community. Teton Valley Youth Alliance is on a mission to make Teton County, Idaho the best place for youth to grow up. Using a county-wide collaborative initiative that utilizes the 40 Developmental Assets® framework created by the Search Institute®, we promote strategies that increase youth's connections to positive relationships and experiences. ReEnvision Victor Update. Whitney Brunner, representing Logan Simpson, made public comment with a power point presentation regarding the comprehensive plan and transportation plan. This included information on the overall process and upcoming schedules and the reviews and community feedback on the second questionnaire that was posted online. Long Term Temporary Merchant License Code Update. Oliva made staff comment regarding the history of this item and the purpose of this code amendment is to add process provisions and definitions, eliminate work arounds of the land use codes and a few housekeeping items. Public Comment was opened. Chris and Laura Furbacher, representing Grand Teton Brewing, made public comment thanking the city for helping them work towards allowing more food options at the brewery.
