PURPOSE & PROCESS

The purpose of this item is to obtain council's approval to accept the proposal from West Pointe Electric to replace the controllers for the lights in Sherman Park and on Main Street.

BACKGROUND/ALTERNATIVES

The lights on Main Street are controlled by two controllers on each side of the roadway. Over the past few years they have deteriorated to the point where staff is regularly performing maintenance and is recommending their replacement. The City has started to gradually replacing all of the older streetlights with the newer standard of streetlights that are more energy efficient. The replacement of the controllers will provide the street light network with a more efficient and up to date system to accommodate the street light replacement efforts of the City. Staff met with West Pointe Electric on site and has inspected the light controllers. Attached is a proposal to replace each of the controllers on Main Street.

Sherman Park provides several opportunities for residents to enjoy outdoor recreation in the City of Victor. One of the services that the City has provided is the ability for park users to turn on the lights with a set timer. This is used frequently by folks in the wintertime who don't get home from work until it is dark. The existing timer has gone bad and is need of replacement at this time. Staff has met with the contractor and had gone over the current configuration of the park light controller. Attached is the resulting proposal from West Pointe Electric to replace the controller.

On behalf of West Pointe Electric, LLC, I am pleased to provide you with an estimate for the electrical work associated with replacing the main control distribution for the lights on both the West and East street lights on Main St Victor, ID. The price is based on the information provided on our site visit with Rob, Nate and team. Also included below is the price to upgrade and fix the timer at the Sherman Park baseball diamonds.

West side controller	\$ 4,315.00
East side controller	\$ 4,315.00
Ball Field lighting controller	\$ 2,445.00

Please note the following clarifications:

- Secondary conduit from the transformer to the new meter is included. Fall River will need to do wire and labor. Their cost is not included in our pricing.
- All labor and material for a complete working system included as discussed.
- No excavation or dirt work included. If you want it included please add \$650 for both the West and East side, unless we do them both at the same time then add \$1,000 total.
- We reserve the right to schedule this work as necessary to fit it in our schedule but will do our best to work within your desired timeframe.
