Working Together: Staff and Council discussion followed with the current zoom meetings that we are holding due to COVID-19, the onboarding of new councilmembers and how to get their questions answered and what the procedure is at council meetings, and how to think and act strategically as a council. Preparing for FY22.

FY2022 Priorities.

City Hall & Public Works Facilities Project: Staff and Council discussion followed with a review of the strategic priorities for the upcoming fiscal year, . Staff comments were made by Kim and Olivia.

Agreement with Sheriff's Office. Staff and Council discussion followed regarding the re-negotiation of the contract between the Sheriff's Office and the City of Victor.
