ORDINANCE 0550

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF VICTOR, IDAHO AMENDING CHAPTER 9 OF TITLE 1 OF THE VICTOR CITY CODE REGARDING CITY EQUIPMENT; AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF VICTOR, COUNTY OF TETON, STATE OF IDAHO:

SECTION 1. Chapter 9 of Title 1 shall be amended and restated as follows:

CHAPTER 9  
CITY EQUIPMENT

SECTION:

- 1-9-1: Authorization of Use
- 1-9-2: Expenses

1-9-1: **AUTHORIZATION OF USE:**

A. The city council authorizes the use of city owned equipment and/or city personnel outside the corporate limits of the city of Victor for emergency purposes, other instances set forth in City of Victor Municipal Code, or otherwise approved by the city council. City owned equipment can only be used by authorized city personnel. (Ord. O550 § 1, 2019, Res. R97-0318, 3-18-1997)

B. No official or employee shall request, use or permit the use of any publicly owned or publicly supported property, vehicle, equipment, labor or service for the personal convenience or the private advantage of himself or any other person. This rule shall not be deemed to prohibit an official or employee from requesting, using or permitting the use of publicly owned or publicly supported property, vehicle, equipment, material, labor or service for which it is the general practice to make available to the public at large or which are provided as a matter of stated public policy for the use of public officials and employees in the conduct of official business. 1-9-2: **EXPENSES:** Expenses incurred for wages, fuel, or any other related expenses must be reimbursed by the agency or persons requesting assistance under an emergency unless otherwise authorized by the mayor or city council. (Ord. O550 § 1, 2019, Res. R97-0318, 3-18-1997)


SECTION 2. All ordinances, resolutions or parts thereof in conflict herewith are hereby repealed, rescinded and annulled.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication, according to law.
