

RESOLUTION R517

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF VICTOR DESIGNATING A RECORDS CUSTODIAN AND ALTERNATE

WHEREAS, the City Council desires that city government be transparent and accountable to the public; and

WHEREAS; Senate Bill 1274 will take effect on July 1, 2018 and requires, in part, that a public agency, elected official or independent public body corporate and politic shall designate a custodian or custodians for all public records, which includes any public official having custody of, control of, or authorized access to public records and also includes all delegates of such officials, employees or representatives.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF VICTOR, IDAHO:

Section 1. That the City Clerk is hereby designated the City of Victor Custodian of Records for all departments and the City Administrator is designated as an Alternate Custodian of Records.

Section 2. That this Resolution shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval.
