

RESOLUTION R522

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF VICTOR, IDAHO, ADOPTING THE TETON COUNTY AFFORDABLE HOUSING STRATEGIC PLAN, DATED FEBRUARY 20, 2019, AS A GUIDING DOCUMENT TO BE USED BY THE CITY IN THE PURSUIT OF PROGRAMS AND INITIATIVES TO ADDRESS AFFORDABLE HOUSING NEEDS OF THE COMMUNITY.**

THIS RESOLUTION, made on the date hereinafter set forth by the City Council of the City of Victor, Idaho, a municipal corporation under Idaho Law, hereinafter referred to as the "City."

WHEREAS, the Victor City Council has received and reviewed the Affordable Housing Strategic Plan, dated February 20, 2019, which was prepared for the cities of Driggs, Teton and Victor and Teton County, Idaho, by the appointed Affordable Housing Technical Advisory Group; and

WHEREAS, the City has previously adopted Resolution No. R-16-07-27, finding there to be a shortage of safe or sanitary dwelling accommodations in the City available to persons of low income or rentals they can afford, and creating the joint Teton County-Driggs-Tetonia-Victor Housing Authority; and

WHEREAS, this Affordable Housing Strategic Plan is expected to be utilized by said joint housing authority;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MEMBERS OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF VICTOR, IDAHO, AS FOLLOWS:

**The City of Victor hereby adopts the Teton County Affordable Housing Strategic Plan, dated February 20, 2019.**

**This Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption and approval.**
